

# 2026 COVENTRY VILLAGE SCHOOL AUSTRALIAN VOTING RESULTS

All articles of business were voted using the Australian Ballot system on March 3, 2026. The polls located at Coventry Community Center opened at Nine O'Clock (9 a.m.) in the forenoon and closed at Seven O'Clock (7 p.m.) in the evening.

**Note: The Town of Coventry has a checklist of 804 registered voters. The number of Australian votes cast during the election was registered at 243. This represents a 30.2% participation in school voting.**

## **SCHOOL DISTRICT VOTING:**

**ARTICLE 1:** To elect a **MODERATOR** for the ensuing year.  
- Matthew Maxwell - elected

**ARTICLE 2:** To elect a **SCHOOL TREASURER** for a 1 year term.  
- Deb Tanguay -elected

**ARTICLE 3:** To elect a **SCHOOL DIRECTOR** for a 2 year term.  
- Charles Conn - Elected - 129  
- Israel Sanville - 94

**ARTICLE 4:** To elect a **SCHOOL DIRECTOR** for a 3 year term.  
- Amanda Hussey - elected

**ARTICLE 5:** Shall the voters of the school district approve the school board to expend **\$5,440,885.00** which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? The Coventry School District estimates that the proposed budget, if approved, will result in per pupil spending of \$15,482.00, which is 6.71% higher than per pupil education spending for the current year.

Article FAILED – Favor (111) / Oppose (128)

**ARTICLE 6:** Shall the voters of the school district appropriate **\$100,000.00** to be added to the Capital Reserve Fund for the necessary building improvements? Approving this article will increase education spending and the tax rate.

Article FAILED – Favor (105) / Oppose (135)
